vCamMX-2+ Playback, Camera Lights and **On-screen Keyboard Controls** 



1	Keyboard Navigation	Use the buttons corresponding to the top, right, bottom, and left arrows to navigate the on-screen keyboard. Then, navigate to and press the Done or Step Back key to save the changes.
2	Pause and Resume	Use this button while recording or playing a video to pause and resume the video.
3	Lower Camera Lights	Lower the camera lights while viewing or recording.
4	Rewind	Rewind the video during playback.
5	Stop	Stop the recording or playing the video.
6	Enter Button	Press while in File Manager to play a selected video.
7	Raise Camera Lights	Raise the camera lights while viewing or recording.
8	Fast Forward	Fast forward the playing video.

Use the Pause/Resume button to pause and resume a recording or Use these buttons to navigate the on-screen keyboard, using the center Enter button to select letters or **Camera lights**
